Funding and managing the Clara Vale Village Hall

Objective 1: improving the Hall's income stream; seeking out grant funding for capital projects; and managing use of the building.

- ✓ Continue to exercise rigorous scrutiny of the hall's finances, regularly monitoring all income and expenditure.
- ✓ Create and cost maintenance plan for inclusion in annual budget.
- Review marketing methods and platforms to ensure efficient use of the Village Hall and maximise income.
- ✓ Encourage villagers to sign up to the Hall's monthly standing order /individual Giving scheme.
- ✓ Encourage regular/new fundraising events and activities.
- Research funding opportunities in line with our objectives and make appropriate grant applications.
- ✓ Support our staff to manage the buildings security, fire and booking systems.
- ✓ Ensure appropriate policies are in place to cover Health & Safety, Safeguarding, Covid, equality etc.

Climate change & sustainability in Clara Vale

Objective 2: to reduce the carbon footprint of the village, aspire to a zero-carbon rated Village Hall; and promote a reduce, reuse, repurpose & recycle culture

- ✓ Explore solar and other renewable energy schemes.
- Insulating the Hall building.
- ✓ Repairing the Hall window frames either replacing glass with 'heritage' glass or similar or explore double glazing to improve insulation.
- ✓ Replace the gas fired Hall boilers and adapt heating system to use a more environmentally sustainable fuel source (eg mine water use).
- Act as a hub for a village wide heating scheme that could include the Hall.
- ✓ Facilitating villagers to take carbon reducing steps such as insulation, using solar power, heat pumps etc.
- ✓ Expanding the number of EV chargers to include 2 rapid chargers with appropriate card swipe charging software.
- ✓ Investigate EV car share schemes.
- ✓ Encouraging other low carbon forms of transport eg cycling, walking.
- ✓ Investigate the use of photo voltaic or solar panels on parts of the Village Hall roof.
- ✓ Consider affiliating to Transition Network and joining Transition West Gateshead.
- ✓ Investigate rewilding the VH grounds; purchasing poly tunnels for residents use & setting up a seed bank.

Culture and learning

Objective 3: to encourage and facilitate the growth of cultural events and individual learning within the village

- ✓ Set up a subgroup for musicians and/or visual artists within the village.
- ✓ Set up a subgroup/arrange some time/space in the Hall for the use of young people.
- Compile a seed bank in the Hall building.
- ✓ Re-establish the village Hall lending library (there is a request to shelve a corner of the kitchen for this purpose).
- ✓ Form a subgroup for senior people in the village to encourage and facilitate independent living.
- ✓ Set up a facility/register of seldom used tools (A Library of Things) to borrow for example hedge trimmers, wallpapers strippers etc.
- Organize 'Fix it' workshops & other workshops on different topics also pull together an informal skill register to facilitate.
- Facilitate online discussion workshops/meetings via Teams or Zoom whilst physical meetings are prohibited due to Covid.

Using the Village Hall Building and grounds

Objective 4: to make the Hall and grounds accessible and encourage a wide range of activity for the benefit of all users

- ✓ Making use of our new kitchen: introduce a pop-up pub (Friday/Saturday nights); in addition to the regular lunch & breakfast events introduce a pop-up internet café on a regular basis for villagers, walkers, and cyclists.
- ✓ Introduce either a pop up or permanent shop in the Hall following on from the success of the mini markets.
- ✓ Hot desking: reintroduce this resource (when the covid situation permits).
- ✓ Ensure previous commitment to installing a hearing loop is completed.
- ✓ Pull together a maintenance plan for the Hall building and Business Centre.
- ✓ Install acoustic panels in the main Hall and meeting room.
- ✓ Install appropriate blinds in Hall windows.
- ✓ When the Hall can reopen encourage our exercise, choir, Clara Talks and other classes to resume.
- ✓ Explore rewilding part of the Village Hall grounds.
- ✓ Purchase poly tunnel(s) for residents to rent growing space in.
- ✓ Ensure there is outside space for the marquee when required.
- ✔ Develop picnic area.
- Support toddler/parents in the village to improve outside space in the park /outside play areas.
